DRAFT NATIONAL GUIDELINE ON MINIMUM INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PREPARING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENTS FOR MINING ACTIVITIES THAT REQUIRE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION

On 9 February 2018 in Government Gazette 41432 Notice Number 86 the Minister of Environmental Affairs published the Draft National Guideline on Minimum Information Requirements for Preparing Environmental Impact Assessments for Mining Activities that Require Environmental Authorisation.

Members of the public are invited to provide written comments or input to the Minister 30 days from date of publication i.e. by 11 March 2018.

The document provides guidance on best practice for EIAs on mining and mineral processing activities.
