



INFORMATION ALERT:

APPOINTMENT OF THE REGISTRATION AUTHORITY IN TERMS OF SECTION 24H OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT 107 OF 1998 (NEMA)

On 8 February 2018 in Government Gazette 41434 Notice Number 104 the Minister of Environmental Affairs, under section 24H(3)(a) and (6) of NEMA, appointed the Environmental Assessment Practitioners Association of South Africa as the single registration authority for environmental assessment practitioners. The appointment will be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of this publication.

In terms of section 22(1) of the Section 24H Registration Authority Regulations, as published in Government Gazette 40154 Notice Number 849 on 22 July 2016, these regulations will come into effect on the date of the appointment of the first registration authority. Therefore the regulations came into effect on 8 February 2018.

The requirement to register as an environmental assessment practitioners takes effect 24 months from the date of appointment of the registration authority, i.e. on **8 February 2020**.
